1. (a) For what values of the constant a is the vector field

conservative?
$$\vec{F} = (3x^2 + 3y^2 \cos(x))\vec{i} + (ay \sin(x) + 5y^3)\vec{j}$$

The Lomain of \vec{F} is simply connected, so we have to cleck $P_y = \hat{Q}_x$:

 $P_y = 6y \cos(x)$
 $Q_x = ay \cos(x)$
 $Q_x = ay \cos(x)$
 $Q_x = ay \cos(x)$

makes \vec{F} conservative.

(b) For the values of a determined in the first part of the question compute the integral

$$\int_C \vec{\mathbf{F}} \cdot d\vec{\mathbf{r}},$$

where C is the semicircle with center $(0, \frac{5}{2})$, radius $\frac{3}{2}$ and $x \leq 0$ oriented counterclockwise.

$$\vec{F}$$
 is conservative. Need to find a polarial function f .

$$f_x = P = 3x^2 + 3y^2 \cos(x) \implies f = x^3 + 3y^2 \sin(x) + g(y)$$

$$f_y = 6y \sin(x) + g'(y) - \frac{1}{2} \sin(x) + \frac{1}{2} \sin$$

2. Compute $\int_C \vec{\mathbf{F}} d\vec{\mathbf{r}}$, where

$$\vec{\mathbf{F}} = \langle 3x^2y + y^3 + 3e^x, 3e^{y^2} + 9 \rangle$$

and C is the semicircle in the upper half-plane from (-2,0) to (2,0). [Hint: Do not attempt to calculate the integral directly.]

3. (a) Let $\vec{\mathbf{F}} = P\vec{\imath} + Q\vec{\mathbf{j}} + R\vec{\mathbf{k}}$ be a vector field and f a function. Fill in the blanks to make the following formula correct

$$\operatorname{curl}(f\vec{\mathbf{F}}) = \underline{\qquad} \times \vec{\mathbf{F}} + f \underline{\qquad} (\vec{\mathbf{F}}).$$

Show your work to justify your answer.

(b) Let $\vec{\mathbf{F}}_1 = P_1 \vec{\mathbf{i}} + Q_1 \vec{\mathbf{j}} + R_1 \vec{\mathbf{k}}$ and $\vec{\mathbf{F}}_2 = P_2 \vec{\mathbf{i}} + Q_2 \vec{\mathbf{j}} + R_2 \vec{\mathbf{k}}$ be two vector fields. What is $\operatorname{div}(\operatorname{curl}(\vec{\mathbf{F}}_1 \times \vec{\mathbf{F}}_2))?$

4. Parametrize the part of the ellipsoid $x^2 + 2y^2 + 2z^2 = 1$ that lies inside the paraboloid $x = \sqrt{3}y^2 + \sqrt{3}z^2$.

5. Find an equation for the tangent plane to the surface given by

$$\vec{\mathbf{r}}(u,v) = \langle u^2, \, 2u\sin v, \, u\cos v \rangle$$

at the point $\vec{\mathbf{r}}(1,0)$.
